

Our son participated in the vision therapy program at Dr. Kari Visser-Robel's office during the 2011-2012 school year. In short, it was a big commitment but well worth the effort. Our son was a solid student. However, he was easily distracted. Teachers commented on his lack of focus in class, and evening homework frequently took too long to complete. Similarly, his verbal reading skills needed to improve. The improvement this school year has been substantial. He is getting more work done in class, the homework that remains is completed quickly, and his reading has improved. His grades, while very good before, are now excellent. Some of this improvement may have come naturally, but I'm confident a significant portion was a result of the therapy program. He is experiencing less eye strain, and this has resulted in better focus.
